

PREPARE FOR MIGRATION

Over the next few weeks there are steps you should take—some required and some recommended—to make your transition to the University of Oregon a bit easier. Use these checklists to help you track your tasks.

REQUIRED

Required steps often have enrollment or other consequences if you miss them. It's important to do these as soon as you can, because you will be very busy when you arrive on campus for fall. This is also a good opportunity to exercise your independence and take care of your college checklist on your own.

- Complete your pre-advising requirements at community.uoregon.edu.
- O Meet with your academic advisor and complete your fall registration.
- □ Complete the IntroDUCKtion requirements at community.uoregon.edu.

 - O Academic integrity module
- □ Send your final transcript(s).
- O Submit your health records in your myUOHealth portal via health.uoregon.edu.
- Accept your billing account terms and conditions via duckweb.uoregon.edu.
- O Complete the required prevention modules beginning on August 31.
- □ Submit your UO ID card photo at uocard.uoregon.edu.
- □ Enroll in DUO two-step authentication at duckid.uoregon.edu.
- Complete your housing registration by July 31, including if you plan to request an exemption to the live-on requirement.
- □ Review and complete any financial aid requirements.

RECOMMENDED

- Check your UO email daily at uomail.uoregon.edu and read it with attention; we cannot stress this enough!
- Text any UO questions to your student orientation staffer—they're here to help!
- □ Sign up for UO Alert—our emergency text message system —via duckweb.uoregon.edu.
- Complete your room selection before July 31 via housing.uoregon.edu.
- Beginning in mid-July, register on Handshake to search for campus jobs.
- □ Read *The A Game*, a book to be mailed to your home this summer.
- Chat with your new roommate if you haven't started. This is the best way to discuss arrivals, sharing supplies for the room, and other essential topics before the year starts.
- Review lists of items to bring and items to leave at home on housing.uoregon.edu.
- O Log in to engage.uoregon.edu to check out student clubs and organizations.
- Plan your trip to Eugene! Don't wait to think about packing, planning travel details, celebrating with friends and families, creating and sharing playlists, and other pre-departure tasks.
- Create a shopping list of supplies you will need. Remember, if you are from another state you can save sales tax by shopping in Oregon.
