Qualifications

Qualified applicants are undergraduate students, carry a minimum of 8 academic credits, and are well-rounded individuals who can speak to their experiences in multiple areas of campus life. Strong candidates will typically:

- 1) Have leadership skills and applicable experiences.
- 2) Have been involved in various aspects of student life: clubs, organizations, cultural groups, work-study, research, student government, etc.
- 3) Have familiarity with various academic and student resources on campus.
- 4) Be confident in their abilities to effectively present the positive attributes of the University of Oregon.
